

Getting Started

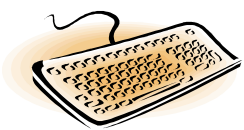
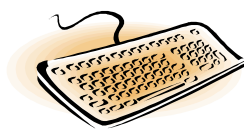
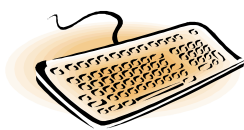

First, position your hands and fingers to match the illustration above.

On your left hand, pinky finger will rest on the **A** key, your ring finger will rest on the **S** key, your middle finger on the **D**, and your pointer finger on the **F** key. Rest your left thumb on the space bar.

On your right hand, rest your pinky fingers on the **;** (**colon, semicolon**) key, your ring finger on the **L**, your middle finger on the **K** and your pointer finger on the **J**.
