

## How to Listen to the Audio Reading Service

There are a number of ways to "tune in" to the Audio Reading Service broadcast. Call us at 260-421-1376 or visit <u>acpl.info/ars</u> for more information and links.

- HD Radio 89.1 FM HD2: Thanks to a partnership with WBOI, anyone with a Hybrid Digital Radio (HD Radio) within range of their signal can listen to our programs. You can request to borrow a free HD Radio pre-tuned to our station from the library, and we will mail it to you. You don't need a library card, and this is a lifetime loan so you can keep it as long as you like; just return it when you're finished using it. We do require that you register with us so we can keep track of these radios. Call us at 260-421-1376 or submit an online form at <u>acpl.info/ars</u>.
- **TV PBS Fort Wayne 39.6:** Thanks to a partnership with PBS Fort Wayne, anyone within range of their broadcast signal can hear our programs 24/7.
