Biographical Note

Richard Wigginton Thompson (1809-1900) was born in Virginia and moved to Indiana in 1831 by way of Kentucky. Thompson studied law and was admitted to the bar in 1834, served in the Indiana Legislature from 1834 to 1836, the Indiana Senate 1836 to 1838, and the United States House of Representatives 1841 to 1843 and 1847 to 1849. Thompson was an influential member of the Indiana Whigs throughout the 1850s before joining the Republican Party.

Thompson's friendship and professional association with Abraham Lincoln began when they served together in Congress beginning in 1847 and continued for the rest of Lincoln's life. Thompson initially supported the Constitutional Union Party ticket in the 1860 election, but switched allegiance to Abraham Lincoln and the Republican Party when it became clear that John Bell, the Constitutional Union candidate, could not win the election. Thompson acted as an intermediary between Lincoln and Governor Oliver Morton of Indiana during the tense early days of the Civil War. In January of 1863, Thompson drafted an unsent 17-page letter opposing Lincoln's Emancipation Proclamation, written "at the suggestion of several conservative members of Congress," many from the border states. Word of the letter reached Lincoln, who addressed Thompson's critiques and eventually earned Thompson's support. Upon Lincoln's assassination in 1865, Thompson traveled to Washington for the funeral and later eulogized his friend for the people of Terre Haute.

Thompson continued to be a prominent political advisor to other Republicans through the latter half of the nineteenth century. He served as Secretary of the Navy from 1877 to 1880, during the presidency of Rutherford B. Hayes. Thompson left his cabinet position to become chairman of the American Committee of the Panama Canal Company in 1881 and director of the Panama Railroad Company from 1881 to 1888. Thompson returned to Indiana upon his retirement and died in Terre Haute on February 9, 1900.

Scope and Content

Richard W. Thompson kept correspondence, papers, pamphlets, and news clippings throughout his career. The majority of Thompson's collection is comprised of letters he received, though he also kept some of his own papers as well as the correspondence and writings

of other notable politicians. His correspondents included local and national politicians, family members, and Indiana citizens. After his death, Thompson's collection became the property of his youngest daughter, Virginia Thompson Henry, and her husband, Judge David W. Henry, of Terre Haute. The Richard W. Thompson Collection was part of a large purchase from the Henrys in 1928 by the Lincoln Historical Research Foundation, and was one of the first foundational collections of what is now the Lincoln Financial Foundation Collection.

Over the years, pieces from the initial Thompson acquisition have been dispersed, both within the Lincoln Collection and to other institutions, including the Indiana State Library and the Rutherford B. Hayes Presidential Center in Fremont, Ohio. The Richard W. Thompson Collection as it stands today is comprised specifically of letters and documents to, by, or about Richard W. Thompson. Thompson's autograph book from the Twenty-Seventh Congress (1841-1843), as well as other Thompson correspondence that was not part of the initial purchase from the Thompson descendants, can be found elsewhere in the Lincoln Financial Foundation Collection.

The Richard W. Thompson Collection is divided into three parts:

Box 1 contains *Letters to Thompson*. Comprising 340 letters, telegraphs, and petitions addressed to Richard W. Thompson, this is the most extensive part of the collection. Letters cover the years of Thompson's career from 1834 to 1897. Correspondents include Indiana residents, national politicians, Cabinet members, and influential Republicans.

Box 2 contains *Documents Created by Thompson*. Thompson kept few copies of letters sent to others. Much of the correspondence in this portion of the collection comprises drafts and incomplete documents. Also included are Thompson's handwritten notes, statements, memoranda, certificates of appointment, programs, news clippings, and scrapbook. After the collection was acquired, the original scrapbook was taken apart and the contents and leather covers made to fit into a standard-sized 3-ring binder, from which it has since been removed.

Box 3 contains *Documents about Thompson*. This box is comprised almost entirely of correspondence referencing Thompson, including invitation responses regarding Thompson's birthday celebrations.
