
Maker Labs Programs



Maker Lab Rules & Guidelines

PREPARE

- Safety is top priority when using the Maker Lab never distract someone who is using a tool or machine.
- Only use tools after you have been properly trained on its use.
- Sign in before using any equipment.

DRESS TO PROTECT

- Do not wear loose-fitting clothing around moving or rotating machinery.
- Tie back or cover long hair.
- Wear only shoes that cover your whole foot no sandals.
- Always wear eye protection when working with machinery.

USE TOOLS CORRECTLY

- Use tools only as they were designed to be used.
- Never use a broken tool and report any broken or malfunctioning tools/machinery immediately.
- Do not remove tools from the Maker Lab space.
- Operate machines only with all safety guards and shields in place.

CLEAN UP

- Clean up every time you leave an area, including sweeping the floor.
- Clean and return tools to their proper places.
- Keep the floor dry and free of any trip hazards.
